- You can keep the cart in your family's room.


"Elephant"

What is Agapé Hospice?

This is a place that gives care to people who have a disease that will not go away and who need special nursing care to help take care of them so they do not live in pain. They live here to be comfortable.



At Agapé Hospice there are nurses, doctors, a social worker, chaplains, and volunteers who will give special attention to you and your family while staying here, because you are very important to your family and us.



What does a hospice look like?

Our hospice looks like a big house on the inside. Every person has their own bedroom and bathroom. There is a kitchen, dining room and living room for everyone to use and visit in. There are lots of couches and comfy chairs to sit in. We also have a flower garden and gazebo. So we are just like your own house and yard.

We know that it is hard for you to live with someone who has a disease that cannot be cured. And we understand that you may feel lonely, angry, scared or sad.

We have a Social Worker, and volunteers who will listen to you and help you talk about your feelings. They also play with you and make you feel welcomed.

Did you know the hospice has a play room? It is called **Mary's Beary Patch**.
