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Policy

As part of the services provided by The Salvation Army Agapé Hospice, there is *no standard fee* for the services of the Chaplain to officiate at a memorial/funeral service for a resident of Agapé Hospice.

Procedure

- 1. Chaplains employed by Agapé Hospice will only provide memorial/funeral services *on behalf of the hospice* for individuals who have been residents at Agapé. Exceptions can be made for family members of staff or in extenuating circumstances.
- 2. Chaplains at Agapé Hospice will make decisions regarding presiding at memorial/funerals on the basis of the following:
 - the needs of the family (with priority given to families who have no congregational attachment);
 - the needs at the hospice at the time of the request;
 - staying within the guidelines set by Agapé Hospice (no more than 3 services per month).
- **3.** Cheques for *funeral services* will be considered compensation for time taken from the Spiritual Care department, and will be directed to *Spiritual Care*. Cheques should be made payable to Agapé Hospice. (*Undesignated memorial* donations will go into *general funds*.)
