INSURANCE – COMPREHENSIVE GENERAL LIABILITY

1. Coverage

This insurance provides coverage for all operations and premises of the Salvation Army in Canada and Bermuda.

The policy covers legal liability for bodily injury and damage to property of others caused by the negligence of the Army its officers, employees or volunteers.
